GORDON BROWN DECENTRALISES THE UK GOLD RESERVES



For many years successive Governments have been under pressure to decentralise Government Departments for a whole catalogue of reasons not least the economic benefits which could accrue to regions such as Cornwall.

In a shock announcement due to be made at this Autumn's Labour Party Conference Gordon Brown – himself a Celt – will announce the

decentralisation of the UK's Gold Reserves. Areas such as the North East, North Wales and Cornwall will benefit in a bold new move designed to underline the Government's commitment to the regions.

The top secret Cornish site to be used to store over a quarter of the UK's current Gold Reserves is Seton Self Storage at Scorrier near Redruth. In the summer of 1969, with flowers in their hair, three Cornish school friends went on an 'A' level Geography Field Trip to the village of Hambledon in Hampshire. This is the village where cricket is claimed to have been invented and home of a village pub called the Bat and Ball.

Although Nigel, Dave and Bob were only 17 years old they were tall for their age and on a couple of occasions slipped away from their tents while everyone else drifted off to sleep to sample the delights of Hordean Special Bitter (HSB) brewed by Gales Brewery.

On their last night, the Friday night, Nigel had 4 pints of HSB which even today has a high specific gravity. The escapade that followed was certainly out of character. The Bat and Ball in those days attracted cricket loving showbiz types including Mick Jagger. On seeing his pop idol Nigel had to get some 'memorabilia' so oblivious of the consequences he used a piece of plastic to ease open the door of Mick Jagger's car and faithfully hid a suitcase full of Jagger's clothes in a hiding place that from that day to this he could not remember.

This year Nigel celebrated his 50th birthday and his two friends and all three wives returned to Hambledon to celebrate. On their last night there, Nigel repeated his HSB antics, this time having 6 pints and promptly

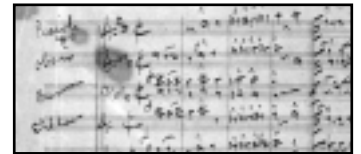
walked into a low beam banging his head. Temporarily out cold he regained consciousness with a vivid picture of a local allotment in his mind.

Six people, each aged circa 50 years digging up a local allotment could have caused annoyance, anger or even overnight accommodation of the constabulary kind but, at last, the suitcase was uncovered. Inside was undoubtedly memorabilia of a young Mick Jagger which Sotherby's could auction for many thousands of pounds.

Sadly the allotment, manured consistently for 33 years had produced enough worms and other organisms indigenous to the earth to simply leave a few remnants of what had been, including a barely recognisable

hand-written set of lyrics for a song called Brown Sugar.
